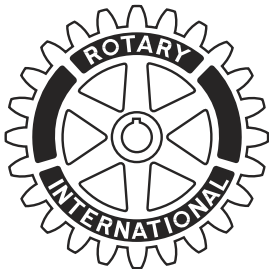
MOTORCYCLE RUN FOR CHAIRITY

Event day registration occurs at the Hitching Post, 2550 Highway 88, St. Anthony Village, MN 55418 (near Minneapolis). Event day registration takes place between 10am and 12:00pm. Run is planned to follow a path northeast of the cities including several restaurant stop locations. Final map will be available in June due to planning to avoid road construction.

Event Activities -

Hopkins activities for the day of the Run include a street fair, beer tent, live music and dancing till midnight. There will be reserved parking for Run participants. An event award ceremony will take place at about 6pm in downtown park. Cash prizes of \$350 for grand prize, \$150 for second prize and \$50 for third prize will be awarded.
